

On July 7, 2006, affiant sent to the Vermont Assistant Attorney General additional documents, including copies of the Summary Notices which appeared in media ads GE purchased in *Parade*, *USA Weekend*, *People*, *Reader's Digest*, and *Better Homes and Gardens*; a copy of the Motion for Final Approval of Settlement, with Exhibits (Docket No. 72); the Stipulation Regarding Supplemental Notice (Docket No. 79); the Order Approving and Ratifying Stipulation Regarding Supplemental Notice (Docket No. 81); and a copy of the Supplemental Notice.


5. No inquiries have been received from any other Attorney General. No objections have been received from any Attorney General.
